# Village Hall



At the AGM the Village Hall
Management Committee
announced that the National
Lottery had indicated a change in
policy and would no longer be
supporting projects such as new
village halls. Although not giving up
entirely, this is probably the only

realistic opportunity to raise sufficient funds for a rebuild. The committee is going to consider reverting to Plan A. This was the phased rebuild/refurbishment of the existing hall which will require alternative planning permissions etc. The PC fully supports the VHMC who will still need to raise significant further funds although not on the scale required for a complete rebuild.

#### **Burial Ground**

The notice board has been replaced – Thanks to Councillor Jason Brown for doing the work. The new gates should be installed very soon.

## **Bus Shelter - Tollesbury Road**

The obscene graffiti was causing offence and Councillor Jason Brown kindly repainted it. Unfortunately, before he was able to apply the anti-graffiti treatment the walls were again defaced. The culprit has been active around the village for some time with a black marker pen and some extremely offensive material. We hope parents will discuss this issue with their children and explain the impacts of graffiti on public property.

# **Speeding in the Village**



This has remained an issue and a delegation from Kelvedon Road attended the Parish Council meeting in February to stress the continued problem in their locality. The Parish Council explained the work done to investigate Vehicle Activated Speed Signs (VASS) but the

residents felt strongly that enforcement was the best solution. As a consequence, we arranged to concentrate the next month's TruCam patrols on Kelvedon Road. Unfortunately, a large van parked on the road (possibly in an attempt to slow traffic) invalidated the area as an enforcement site so the patrols were unable to proceed. The Maldon District Council Community Protection Officers are discussing the location with Essex Police and will report back on the potential for enforcement. The issue was also raised at the Annual Assembly and County Councillor Mark Durham explained some of the backgrounds whilst agreeing that enforcement was very effective. Unfortunately for different reasons, we are unable to proceed with VASS in Tollesbury Road and Church Street. Although the powers of the Parish Council are extremely limited for speeding, we will be pursuing this issue further.

### **Precept**

As predicted in the last issue the precept has been maintained at the same level for the second year. This has meant that most people saw a small reduction in their contribution. Probably went unnoticed with all the other increases.
