APPROVE subject to the following conditions:-

1 **CONDITION**

The works hereby permitted shall be carried out in accordance with the British Standard Recommendations for Tree Works (BS3998:2010).

REASON

To safeguard the health and appearance of the tree.

2 **CONDITION**

The works hereby permitted shall be carried out within 2 years from the date of this permission.

REASON

To ensure that the works are carried out whilst they are still relevant to the condition of the tree.

3 **CONDITION**

The Ash tree, the subject of the proposed works, shall be replaced with a Cherry, non-fruiting variety of Apple or a Pyrus Calleryana Chanticleer with a stem girth of 10cm - 12cm and installation of a root deflector or similar to prevent future root development, in a similar location to the Ash Tree, within 6 months of the felling (within the terms of condition 2), in the first relevant year (s), and shall be planted between March and September.

REASON

To secure appropriate replanting of the site in the interests of visual amenity and the character and appearance of the surrounding area

INFORMATIVE

The applicant is advised that whilst consent is hereby granted to carry out works to the tree subject to a Tree Preservation Order from the Local Planning Authority, it is considered that this tree may offer wildlife habitat value. The applicant is advised that it is an offence to disturb, kill or injure protected species and their associated breeding site/s and/or resting place/s under the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 and The Conservation of Habitats and Species Regulations 2017. Should a protected species be found during the course of the works, the applicant should stop work and contact Natural England for further advice.
