Dear Michelle I hope that you are well. Please can you pass the following on to Councillors for their consideration.

**Dear Councillors** 

I am sure that I am not the only person to raise concerns about the situation in D'Arcy Way which now seems to be an overspill car park for the school, village hall and scout hut users.

I am a resident of D'Arcy Way and have noticed how the number of vehicles parked on the road has significantly increased in the last month or so. I have counted as many as fifteen cars parked end to end from right on the junction with Tollesbury Road to at least half way up the straight part of D'Arcy Way, thereby turning it into a single track road with a blind junction for those entering and exiting onto the main road. It is not possible to see either way if there are oncoming vehicles. I have also seen residents struggling to reverse cars safely out of their own drives due to the number of parked cars. This evening as I drove home the situation was like a slalom course, with cars parked on either side of the road, almost opposite each other. This is very dangerous and I also fail to see how an emergency vehicle could safely access the top of D'Arcy Way when this happens.

I do wonder how much consideration was given to car parking when the Council allowed the Gymnastics Club to open, thereby worsening an already difficult situation.

Perhaps some Councillors could pay a visit to D'Arcy Way to see the problem for themselves – Thursday mornings seem particularly bad.
